## Should Include:

- Service to the Bands

- Cleaning instruments/band trucks/all band spaces
- Water balloons at band camp
- Clean storage rooms

- Band festival fundraising
- “Big Mo” drum staffing
- Relay for Life
- High School honor bands
- Ushering concerts
- Helping out High School Bands
- Cards for Veterans
- Adopt-A-Street
- Running Concession stands
- Fill up water jugs during football games
- Provide apples/snacks for marching band
- Root beer floats (at band camp)!
- Inter-fraternal dodge ball fundraiser
- Band Day Clinics
- Redecorating PRIDE letters
- Helping staff marching festivals
- Instrument Petting Zoo
- Taking out recycling
- Rebuild percussion storage
- Cleaning the football stands after games
- Equipment moving
- Put seat covers on bleachers
- Community involvement
- Uniform maintenance
- Uniform/instrument check-in/out

# Musicianship

## Should Include:

- Activities that support music making
- Activities that create music

## Examples of Musicianship:

- (TBS) Women in School of Music awards
- Personal growth
- Playing your instrument often!
- Participating/Performing in Band
- Hosting/Participating in Reading Bands
- Assist in music major auditions
- Practice hours
- Traveling pep bands
- Honorary Initiations

# Brotherhood/ Sisterhood

## Should Include:

- Activities that develop/promote positive relationships

## Examples of Brotherhood/Sisterhood:

- Sisterhood sleepovers
- Recruiting new members/recruitment events
- Formals
- Camping/Lock-ins
- Corn Maize social events
- Ice cream!
- Attending District Convention!
- Pie-off and Chili Cookout
- Chapter meeting activities
- Alumni interviews
- Diversify (bring in new people)
- Potato Sigma (potluck social)
- Bonding through service activities
- Disney/Rock Band/Smash Bros
- Dodge ball tournaments
- Officer and Committee Head bonding
- Weekly brotherhood/sisterhood dates
- Tutoring other brothers/sisters
- Perform charity

# Leadership

## Should Include:

- Events/Activities that promote/highlight leadership development

## Examples of Leadership:

- Leadership Development Speakers
- (TBS) Women in Music speakers
- Mock interviews for leadership positions in marching band
- Volunteering to head projects
- District Events (Convention, CLC, District Days)!!
- Being a good example
- Recruitment
- Drum Major/Section leader clinics
- Inspire (welcome others, lead)
- Actively developing your leadership skills
